The California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC) Energy Division CEQA Unit has conducted a completeness/deficiency review of the proposed Cabrillo – Santa Ynez Proponent's Environmental Assessment (PEA) and Application (A. 09-07-010) that was filed on July 9, 2009. According to the requirements of the CPUC's Information and Criteria List, the CPUC Energy Division concludes that the PEA/Application is now complete.

While the PEA and Application are considered to be complete based on CPUC requirements, the environmental team may still require additional information from PG&E in order to prepare a complete and adequate CEQA document.
