The Energy Division of the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) has completed its review of Pacific Gas and Electric's (PG&E) Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) Application (A.25-04-004) and Proponent's Environmental Assessment (PEA) for the S-238 Hinkley Compressor Station Electrical Upgrades Project (project). The CPUC reviewed PG&E's application in accordance with Section 15101 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, CPUC's Guidelines for Energy Project Applications Requiring CEQA Compliance: Pre-filing and Proponent's Environmental Assessments (PEA) (November 2019), and the CPUC's Information and Criteria List. The Energy Division finds that the Application and PEA contain sufficient information to satisfy the requirements of the Commission's Information and Criteria List and PEA Checklist. Accordingly, the CPUC deems this Application complete.

While the application is considered complete, the CPUC has identified data requests in the attached Data Request #1. The CPUC requests that PG&E respond to the attached Data Request #1 by May 21, 2025. In addition, the CPUC may have additional data requests during preparation of the CEQA documentation for the project.
