My wife attended the recent Informational Workshop on Draft EIR concerning the SDG&E Proposed Sycamore-Peñasquitos 230-kV Transmission Line Project, held in Rancho Peñasquitos on September 29, 2015.

She listened to and viewed the presentation made by Allison Turner of Katz & Associates, Billie Blanchard, CPUC and Jeff Thomas, Panorama Environmental. After reviewing the handouts and reports online, I am submitting my comments and recommendation so that it may be considered in the Final Environmental Impact Report.

I do not agree with the Proposed Project route, but would support the Alternative 5 as the Primary Route. The current Proposed Project would add additional high-voltage lines close to homes, schools and neighborhood parks. It would diminish home values in the area. There would also be an increase risk of fires due to the overhead lines. Additionally, the aviation balls that will be added to these new lines will impact and diminish our views of our mountains and surrounding area.

Please consider alternative 5 as the Primary Route for this project.
