The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) Energy Division CEQA Unit has reviewed the Nest Buffer Reduction Request #6 submitted by San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) on May 17, 2017 for the Sycamore-Peñasquitos 230-kV Transmission Line Project. The CPUC's comments on the Request are provided below, which has been uploaded as a response attachment to SDG&E's SharePoint site for the Nest Buffer Reduction Request #6 (SXPQ-10200-ENV-TR).

Nest Buffer Reduction Request #6 is approved with the following conditions:

- Killdeer are very noisy birds and are also active at night. A biological monitor needs to be present during the first few hours when initial nighttime activities occur within approximately 100 feet from the nest to evaluate whether the construction noise (e.g., saw cutting) and other physical disturbance near the nest starts to disrupt the birds.
- Increase or reinstate the buffer if there are signs of significant disturbance and risk of project-induced nest abandonment consistent with Mitigation Measure Biology-7.
