Yes, I dropped off a copy with Chief Hernandez. Small section on the base from the substation to Pomerado Rd. We only need to know your comments regarding the following:

1) Mitigation Measure Fire-2: Maintain Emergency Access. SDG&E and/or its contractors shall have fire suppression equipment on all construction vehicles. Construction personnel shall be required to park vehicles away from dry vegetation. SDG&E and/or its contractors shall contact and coordinate with the MCAS Miramar Fire Department and applicable local fire departments (i.e., City of San Diego and City of Poway) prior to construction to determine the appropriate amounts of fire equipment to be carried on construction vehicles and to coordinate fire suppression activities (e.g. make sure construction equipment and personnel would not create obstructions to firefighting equipment or crews). SDG&E shall submit verification of its consultation with MCAS Miramar and local fire departments to CPUC at least 30 days prior to construction.

2) Mitigation Measure Fire-3: Water Tanks. SDG&E and/or its contractors shall have water tanks and/or water trucks sited/available at active Project sites for fire protection during Project construction. Prior to construction, SDG&E and its contractors shall contact and coordinate with the MCAS Miramar Fire Department and applicable local fire departments (i.e., City of San Diego and City of Poway) to determine the appropriate minimum capacity and locations for the water tanks if water trucks are not used. SDG&E shall submit verification of its consultation with MCAS Miramar and local fire departments to CPUC at least 30 days prior to construction.
